1. This is a tall, green (and yellow) masterpiece that greets you as you enter the town of Taber.
2. The men have fallen, but this still stands. This statue has stood in the center of town since 1928 and is where yearly Remembrance Day ceremonies are held.
3. This is the place where people perform outside and is used during the yearly summer harvest festival.
4. 5 days of every week you spent at this building, usually full of laughter and voices, now the hallways ring empty.
5. Now silent, this is where, not long ago, children played under the name of a lion.
