As you have likely heard on the news, the Premier and Minister announced that schools will be welcoming students for the school year under Scenario 1, which is near-normal daily operations with added health measures. Horizon's re-entry plan is built in alignment with the province's relaunch strategy, re-entry plan, and Healthy Guidance for School Re-Entry.
