 - Four core (LA, Math, Soc, Sci) semester/yr. long
 - Math K and E
 - Enrichment (core class addition)
 - Physical Education
 - Computers
 - Options chosen by students (max. three)
 Band counts as two choices = full year
- It is recommended that a student achieve a minimum of 65% in the grade 9 cores in order to move into a higher stream in grade 10..

During the 2021/2022 school year, all grade 9 students will be registered in the subjects of Language Arts, Math, Social, Science, Physical Education, Health, and Computers. In addition, students will also take Core Enrichment. Enrichment class offers additional time (in quarter terms) in which students receive instruction in Language Arts, Math, Social, and Science.
