- Students will be registering online at school on April 13 & 14 for the upcoming 2022/2023 school year. Please review the following courses, the core course streaming charts on the reverse side of this form, attached Graduation Requirements, Detailed Academic Report (grade 10 & 11 students) and Credential Requirement Checklist (grade 10 & 11 students). These documents will assist you and your child in determining the courses they will need for the upcoming school year. **We are asking that parents sign this form, after reviewing and discussing it with your child, and then return it to your Block 7 teacher by Friday, April 1.**
- Grade 10 students must enroll in a full schedule. A full schedule includes a total of 16 blocks for the school year. **5 credit courses = 2 blocks and 3 credit courses = 1 block.** PE 10 and CALM (Career and life Management) are graduation requirements and are recommended to be taken in grade 10. In grade 11 students must complete a minimum of 75 cumulative credits and are able to take up to two spares. (need a minimum of 14 blocks). In Grade 12 students must complete a minimum of 100 cumulative credits.
- We offer an accelerated version of Science 14/ 24 and Math 20-3/ 30-3 in one semester. (2 blocks)

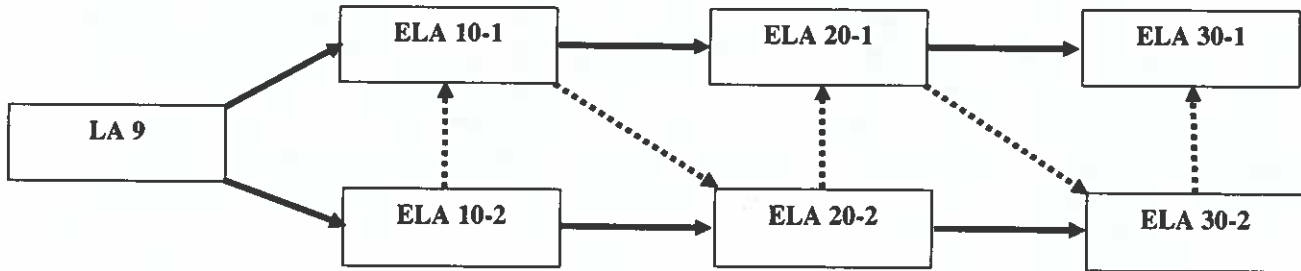

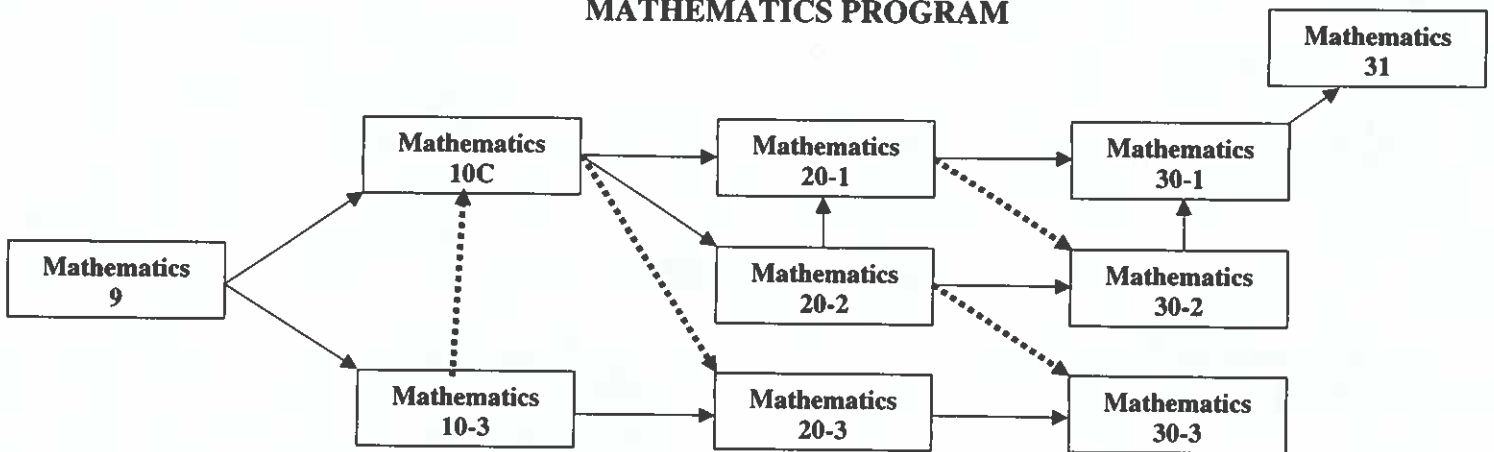
Typical Progression  $\longrightarrow$

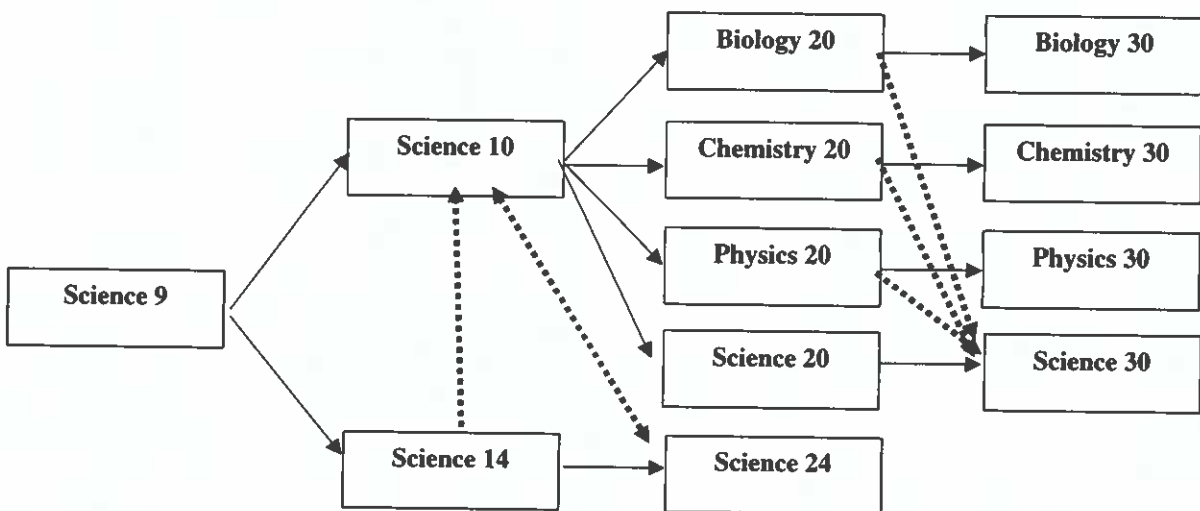
